## **Partners**

The EDENE program aims to train future researchers while developing their capacity for innovation, through collaborations between research centers of excellence and public / private partnerships. But it also aims to strengthen collaborations with socio-economic players in the area and cross-border university players. For this, 7 partners are collaborating with the UPPA:

- the University of Zaragoza,
- international companies (TotalEnergies, Enedis, NALDEO, Teréga),
- · a competitiveness cluster (POLE AVENIA) and
- a technology transfer office (Aquitaine Science Transfert SATT)
